The In the Neighborhood program is a series of short, how-to videos created by people in the Greater Paw Paw Area. The videos will be shared on the Paw Paw District Library's webpage and YouTube channel. Everyone is welcome to participate.

Creating a video

Choose a topic and demonstrate something you know. This can be anything from how to make a sandwich to how to make a sawhorse.

Videos should short, between 2-8 minutes.

Record in a quiet place with good lighting with the device's camera set to landscape,

Start your video with an introduction "I'm Sarah from Paw Paw and I'm going to show you how to..."

No additional editing or captions are needed. The library will add these.

Submitting a video

When your video is finished, submit the file to the library.

Upload your video to Dropbox or Google Drive (or any file sharing site of your choice) and share the link with the library at ppdl49079@yahoo.com

In addition to sharing the link, send an email to ppdl49079@yahoo.com with your name, contact information and what you are demonstrating in your video.

If you have any problems submitting your video, please contact us by email.

Posted videos

Once your video is received, you will be asked to give permission to post your video.

The library will add In the Neighborhood titles and captions to your video and may perform small edits.

When your video is posted online, you will receive an email with links to its location.
